##### MODULE SUMMARY

This module explores the use of the 12 lead electrocardiogram (ECG) as an assessment tool. It will enable students to gain confidence in interpreting ECGs by reviewing fundamental principles and applying these principles to common electrocardiographic findings. The use of a systematic analysis tool will augment the learning.
