MODULE SUMMARY

This module is for healthcare practitioners working in the operating department who wish to develop a career in anaesthetics to enhance the care given to patients in their progression through the operating department. Practitioners who wish to follow an anaesthetic career in the operating department must complete this module prior to undertaking 'Principles of Perioperative Practice' and must successfully complete both modules to gain competence. This accumulates 400 hours in anaesthetic practice.

- have completed either intern or departmental programme in the perioperative environment
