## Emergency Care Practitioner/ Paramedic Practitioner

### Drugs and Therapeutics

#### MODULE SUMMARY

The module examines some of the more important groups of drugs encountered by healthcare practitioners. The therapeutic and adverse effects are discussed, together with important interactions and an examination of how individual differences can alter drug response and treatment. Part of the course will be delivered online.

#### ENTRY CRITERIA

- The Emergency Care Practitioner pathway is open to staff who are supported by a Trust in this role. The Paramedic Practitioner pathway is only open to registered paramedics normally with a minimum of three years experience. Students are advised to have some knowledge of the physiological and pathophysiological processes relevant to the drug groups covered
