MODULE SUMMARY

This module aims to enhance the knowledge, skills and development of autonomous practitioners, in the partnership between client/practitioner in the management of minor injuries.

The emphasis will be on developing advanced communication and assessment skills, upper and lower limb assessment, eye injuries and practical plastering and suturing workshops.

ENTRY CRITERIA

- The student's work environment must support the role of autonomous practice
- Students must have access to and arrange a practice placement within an NHS Walk-In Centre, A&E department or minor injuries treatment unit, of at least five days duration
