##### MODULE SUMMARY

This module offers healthcare practitioners an exposure to the knowledge and skills pertinent to clinical reasoning and physical examination techniques. This course will enable practitioners to achieve the vision of the Darzi Report (2008) that emphasises the need for timely access to health services, care closer to home and effective care plans for those with long term conditions. It offers the evidence base for specific health assessment techniques to compliment practice.
