# MSC HEALTHCARE EDUCATION AND CLINICAL LEADERSHIP

This innovative course is designed for professional healthcare workers and mentors who are keen to learn more about teaching and management techniques, links theory to practice by combining academic teaching and work-based learning. It covers theories of leadership and managing change within both UK and world healthcare provision, and enables you to carry out projects that are relevant to your workplace. Many of our students have been promoted as a direct result of studying this course.

### CORE MODULES

- Health and social care in context (15 credits)
- Managing change in practice (15 credits)
- Leadership in practice (15 credits)
- Teaching and learning (15 credits)
- Evaluating health and social care outcomes (15 credits)

- Research methods in healthcare practice (15 credits)
- An academic paper (20 credits) and reflective summary + viva (40 credits) or an academic paper (20 credits) and dissertation (40 credits)

### Assessment

Reflection, Viva examination, written assignment.
