

## Faculty of Health, Social Care and Education Interview and Selection Day Checklist

### Before the interview and selection day

- Please confirm by telephone or email whether you will be attending the interview or to arrange an alternative date if you're unable to attend on the date offered.
- Collect together all the **documents you need to bring** with you on the day and **make a photocopy of each** (you need to bring each original document plus one photocopy)
- Print, complete and sign the **Criminal Records Self-Declaration Form**
- Print two copies of the **Student Learning Contract**- one to sign and return to us on the interview day, and one to keep for yourself
- Prepare for your interview by thinking about your motivation to study, your knowledge of the profession to which you are applying, and your relevant skills and qualities.

### Checklist of the documents you must bring with you

Photographic evidence of your identity	<p>ONE of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Passport, or EU/national identity card, or travel/immigration document or Home Office letter</li> <li>▪ Photocard driving licence</li> <li>▪ Photographic student travelcard</li> <li>▪ Photographic student identification from your school or college</li> </ul> <p>OR</p> <p>photograph verified by a recognised professional plus their written statement</p>
Criminal Record Self-Declaration Form	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Criminal Record Self-Declaration Form completed and signed</li> </ul>
Educational qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Proof of qualifications listed on your application form (eg. certificates) including your original NMC PIN or registration documentation</li> </ul>
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Signed Student Learning Contract</li> </ul>
