## Interview and selection programme

09.15 Arrive – Registration

Please have to hand the documents we have asked you to bring:

- Your photographic identification (e.g. passport)
- One copy of your identification document for your file
- Your completed Declaration of Suitability for Social Work form

09.30 Written test – an essay on a topic relating to social work

10.00 Presentation about the Social Work programme by a member of academic staff, and an opportunity to ask any questions you may have.

10.30 Applicants will be divided into groups for the remainder of the selection process, and will be given the details of when and where to be for each activity.

10.45 The Selection process starts. You will undertake the interviews, group role-play and campus tour (normally with a current social work student) with groups rotating until all applicants have completed the exercises.

The selection should conclude before 14.00hrs, however please be aware that on a busy day we may overrun. You will be able to leave as soon as you have completed the process
