- 11.30**                    **Groupings for multiple-mini interviews**  
You will be placed into groups of 5 people and allocated your timeslot. Slots are allocated in order of arrival
- 12.00 – 12.30**        **Lunch break**

- 12.30**                    **Multiple-Mini Interviews**
- The interviews are 30 minutes long and are run at 45 minute intervals. There are 5 candidates per group and 2 groups running simultaneously, meaning that there are 10 students being interviewed in total in each timeslot.
